Presented as a quartet, but with the surprising collabo-ration of a stunning Big Band in very well chosen moments. It offers a con-temporary, open and experimental sound, straight melodies and arrange-ments that wander from groove to European sounds, not neglecting her Basque roots. **Noa has written several original songs exclusively for this fresh new album, which also includes songs by some of the greatest jazz composers of the country**. It sends a positive but also a re-volutionary message. An internal evolution and revolution, change, action.



TROUBLEMAKER has been mixed and mastered by the great engineer Pete Karam (Pat Metheny, Ray Charles, Eric Clapton...). Noa Lur has produced the album with Moisés Sánchez, also in charge of the musical arrangements. Many renowned musicians and artists have collaborated in the making of Troublemaker, such as Christian Scott or Antonio Lizana. The best jazz musicians in the country have recorded songs for this album.
